

## BYLAW #04-11

### A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHEATLANDS NO. 163 TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wheatlands No. 163, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. In this Bylaw, the expression:
  - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act;
  - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Traffic Safety Act*.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than Fifty (50) kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows:

North of the SE Section 12, Township 18, Range 2, West of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Meridian, from a point abutting the most northeasterly corner of the said Section to its most southeasterly corner of NE Section 01, Township 18, Range 2, West of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Meridian, a distance of approximately 1 mile.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty Bylaw of this municipality.
